



Lighting Technician (Arley Hall, Cheshire)

A night-time woodland trail filled with magical creatures and wizarding wonders from the Harry Potter and Fantastic Beasts films, guests explore the sounds, lights, and special effects that bring the magic of the Wizarding World to life. The trail has already won awards within the experiential tourism industry and is set to become a global project. With expansion plans for multiple sites around the world, with a focus on Europe and America in 2022-23, we are expanding our team to facilitate this exciting growth.

Overview:

We are looking for an experienced Lighting Technician to work with a team delivering an outdoor experience.

We are looking for someone to operate and maintain a lighting rig with multiple GrandMA control system, electrical effects and integrated set electrics.

The experience is open daily from October through to January from approximately 4pm - 11pm daily, depending on twilight hours.

There will be a team of 3 in the department, each person will work 5 days a week, so there will always be at least 2 people on site. You will be responsible for the weekly calls, deliveries if required and maintaining the production values while the experience is in operation.

You will work closely in a team with other departments including sound, video and Production Management in order to support all departments where required. Due to the nature of the show and the fact it is a rolling immersive experience, it will be running multiple timecode/ Midi streams from multiple locations and therefore you should have a good understanding of GrandMA control systems.

There is a large LED rig along with multiple moving light locations, show set electrics, effects machines and other generic units that will need maintaining.

Job Role:

- Power on and off over the whole site
- Focus checks and re lamp and colour as required
- Ensure all lighting equipment is in working order and carry out tests
- General maintenance
- Report back to the Lighting Designer/ Production if there are any issues. \
- Support LX 2 and 3

Key requirements:

- Technical knowledge and lighting skills
- Manual dexterity and a good level of physical fitness
- The ability to work well under pressure and to deadlines
- Time management and organisational skills
- The ability to lead a team
- Effective communication skills
- Attention to detail
- Problem-solving ability
- GrandMA based control Knowledge
- Understanding of health and safety legislation and procedures.
- Plant 3A and 3B licences.
- An understanding of outdoor entertainment
